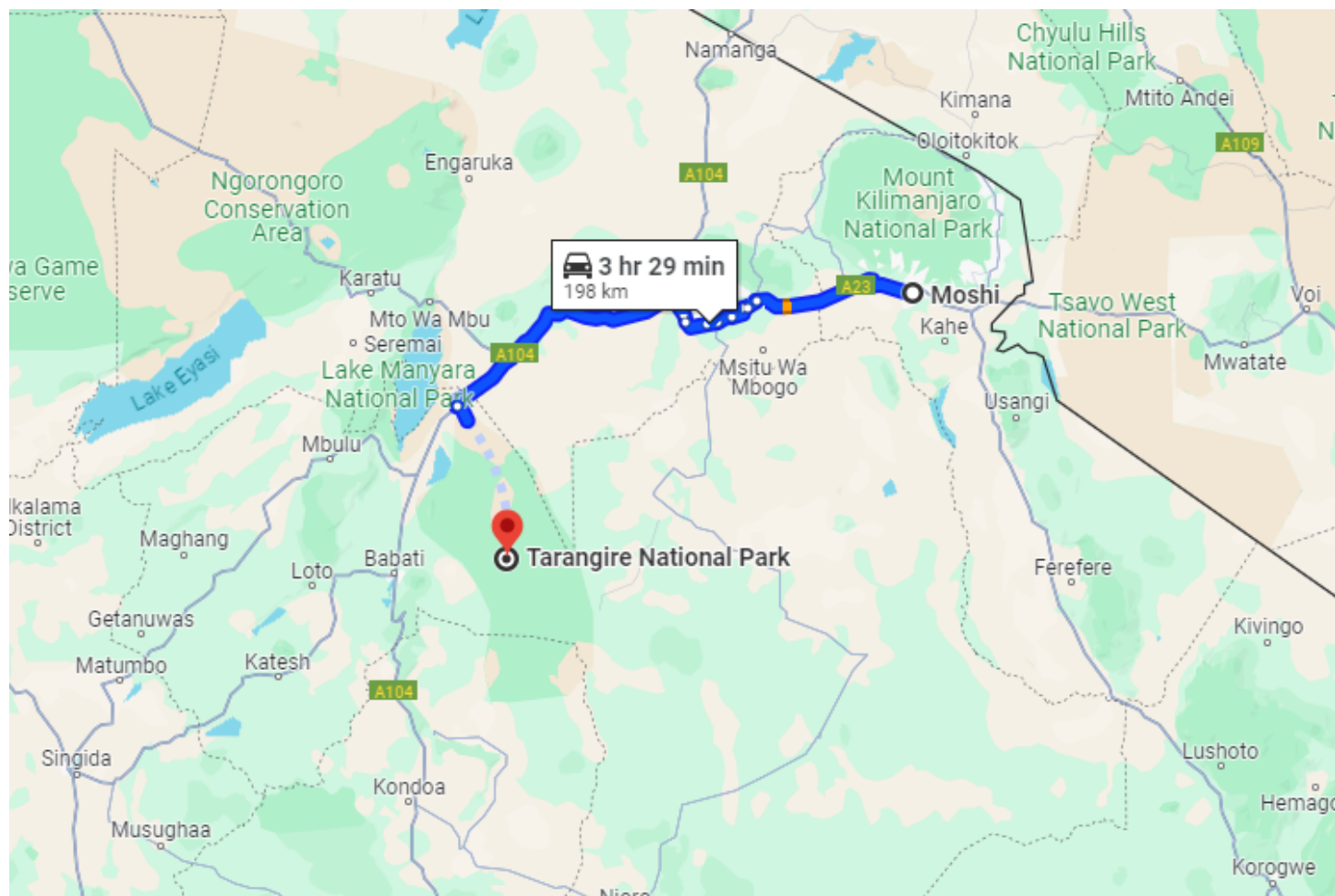
Transportation

Taxis, public transportation, or rent a car

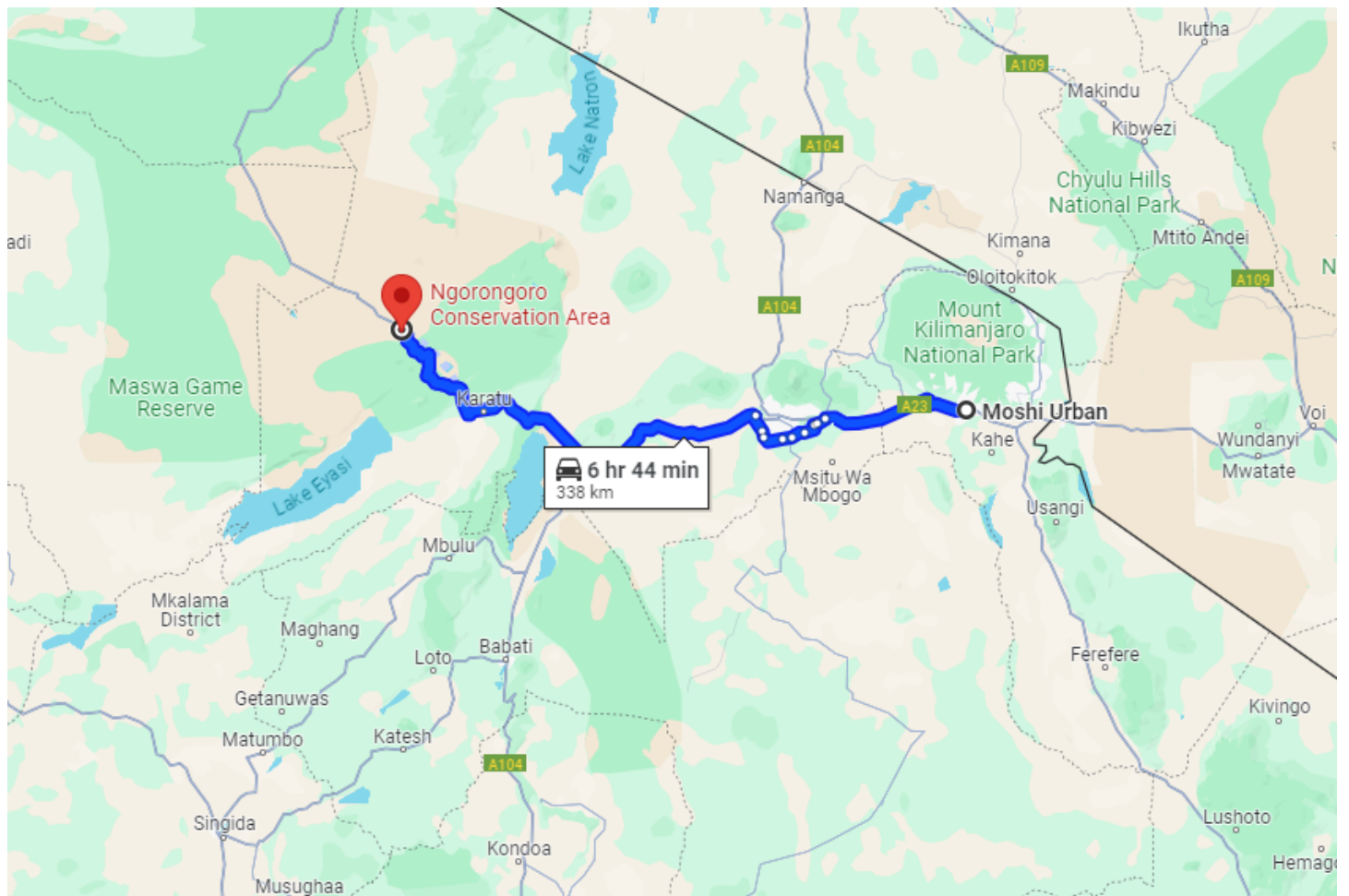

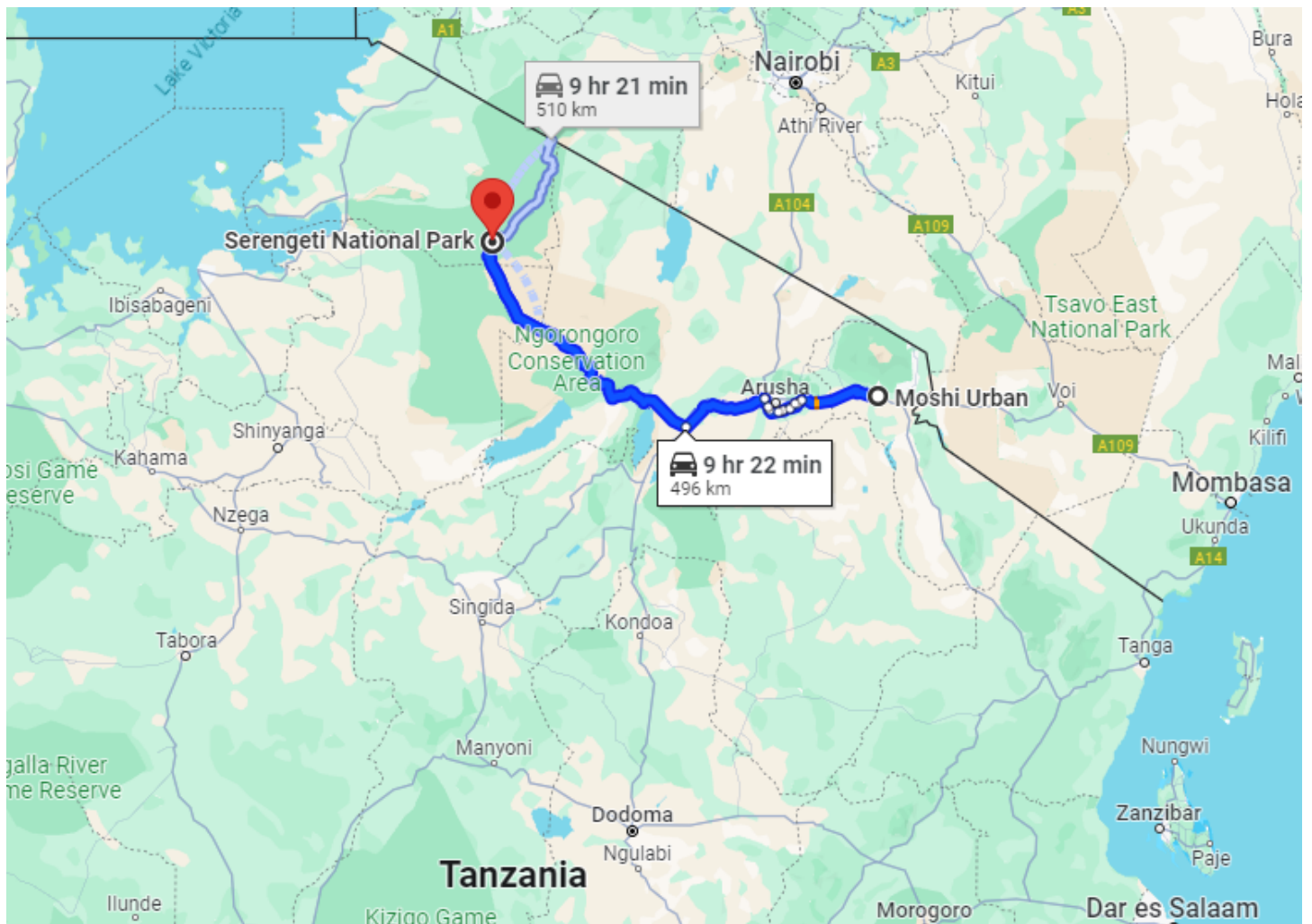
